LETTER FROM OUR FOUNDERS

Alhamdulillah 2023 has been a year of tremendous growth for us at The Majlis. When we started back in 2017 we slowly built up momentum leading to our independent space in 2019. The pandemic put a halt on that momentum and in the years afterwards we have been working towards building up again. Alhamdulillah, this year feels like it was an important year for us in that regard.

We have been able to be consistent in our regular programming, growing and nurturing our committed community members, while also providing occasional bigger programs for added enrichment. We had some great qiyams at local masajid in Ramadan, another wonderful ladies retreat, and another family retreat.

This year we also had an umrah trip, our first since 2019 which was really great. Alhamdulillah about 60 people joined us from our local community and other places and we had a beautiful trip to the sacred places, even being met by our esteemed teacher and advisor, Shaykh Muhammad Haydara on our first day in Medinah.

We also welcomed this year Shereen Youssef as our Executive Director. What began as an interim role slowly developed into a fuller position. While she is still serving in a part-time capacity, the support and expertise that she has brought to the organization and its management has been extremely helpful for us as we continue to grow.

Finally, this year we launched The Majlis Seminary with our first offering, The Anas ibn Malik Community Servants program. It is a unique, two-year online program that is self-paced with quizzes and chat group support. The goal of the program is to provide students with a basic level of knowledge of the tradition that enables them to serve in various capacities in their communities, such as board members and volunteers. We have had great engagement so far and hope that this program will be a source of benefit for many in the future.

We have always tried to grow at The Majlis prioritizing staff and making staffing and space decisions accordingly. We are grateful for your support in the past and going into the future and are hopeful about what we will be able to do together in the years to come. And all praise is due to Allah, in the beginning and in the end.

The Majlis San Diego

Alhamduliah, The Majlis now provides in-person programs in San Diego every Sunday. This year included many classes taught by Shaykh Jamaal Diwan titled "The Art of Community: Adab Al-Suhbah" "Understanding the Sacred Law" and "Futuwwah: The Muslim Honor Code". Additional program include a children's class of story time, crafts, and songs hosted by Shaykha Muslema Purmul and the San Diego volunteer team. Shaykha Muslema also taught her bi-weekly ladies' circle sessions in San Diego and online. Our hope is to continue our San Diego programs as we cultivate and grow the community in the region insha'Allah.









Serving The Nobles



Serving the nobles is a program that provides around 200 meals a month. This beneficial food distribution has been successfully implemented with the support of our local partner, Sabil. Alhamdulilah, every third Sunday of the month, The Majlis volunteers pass hot food and groceries to many local families in need. This year, alhamdulliah we have been able to distribute over 8,500 hot meals.

ladies' study circle





Carrying the momentum from the Ladies' Circle established in 2020 and continuing into 2023 for tazkiah, aqidah, and fiqh, this year's focus was knowing Allah and knowing ourselves, taught by Shaykha Muslema Purmul. While the ladies' circle was previously exclusively online and garnered worldwide attendance, this year's circle took place bi-weekly in person in San Diego and maintained the virtual component for those not local. The circle examined a specific attribute and name of Allah each session with special spiritual reflections to help attendees better know themselves and thus work toward our purpose of better knowing God. In addition to studying the Beautiful Names and Attributes of God, this year, the Ladies Circle also started and finished Imam Ghazali's work, The Beginning of Guidance. We plan to continue the ladies' circle in the new year inshaAllah.





Ladies Retreat

In May 2023, The Majlis had the unique opportunity to host its second annual full-day retreat for ladies titled "Nourishing the Mind, Body, and Soul" with the goal of providing rest, bonding, and spiritual growth to the women of our community who in turn rejuvenate their communities. Local and international speakers included Shaykha Muslema Purmul, Dr. Mona Hasan, Reehab Ramadan, Chaplain Sondos Kholaki, Dr. Aicha Sebaa and Yasmin Elhady. Over 220 women attended the program, which included meals, a beautiful bazaar with over 10 vendors, dhikr and prayer, and sessions on healing the spiritual heart, reviving the sunnah of compassion, connecting to God's Beautiful Attributes, and well being and nutrition. Set at the Hotel Maya Resort in Long Beach California, sessions took place against a stunning backdrop of palm trees, the ocean and the infamous California landmark The Queen Mary. This one of a kind event was one that made a difference to the women serving our community as they nourished their hearts with a meaningful experience.

Refreshing the fundamentals of faith, practice, and spiritual beauty






The Majlis Seminary

Anas ibn Malik Community Servants Program

As part of further developing the overall mission of The Majlis and taking it to as many people as possible, this year we officially launched a two-year seminary program called the Anas ibn Malik Community Servants Program. The goal of the program is to provide a rigorous, reliable Islamic Studies program to the public in a way that is easy for them to be part of and enables them to serve in their respective communities. This program will be teaching a total of 32 courses over the course of the next two years. All content is available online for students to access at their own pace and convenience and further support is provided through dedicated chat groups and conference calls. Alhamdulillah our first cohort was a great success with over 100 students enrolled around the country and the world.


